The Organising Committee invites all interested individuals to submit abstracts for SiPPAC 2023 Congress.

We invite research-based or quality improvement-based abstracts from Doctors, Medical Students, Allied Health Professionals and Nurses.

Accepted abstracts will be selected for oral or poster presentations. Outstanding abstracts will be selected for oral presentation and poster awards.

Closing Date

All abstracts must be submitted by **31 April 2023**. Abstracts submitted after the deadline will not be considered.

> Rules for Submission

- **1.** All abstracts must be submitted using the Abstract Submission Form. All completed abstracts are to be submitted to conference secretariat at **secretariat@sps.org.sg**
- 2. We regret that faxed abstracts will not be accepted.
- **3.** Please ensure the correctness of your abstract as it will be published as submitted; i.e. any error appearing in the submitted abstract will appear in the published book or website.
- **4.** All presenting authors must register for the conference.

➤ Abstract Format

- 1. Font: Times New Roman, regular, only
- 2. Size: 10 points only
- 3. Single space and justify the text
- 4. Limit the content to 300 words
- 5. Do not include any pictures and references in the abstract
- **6.** Underline the name of the presenting author. Institution affiliation should follow list of presenting author(s).
- **7.** The content of the abstract is to be organized as follow:
 - Background/Aim: inform about the aim and objectives of the research;
 - Methods: explain the basis of the techniques which were used;
 - Results: describe the main results;
 - Conclusion: list the main findings of your investigations.
 - Sustainability: analyse if the result is sustainable or repeatable

Submission and Notification

- **1.** All abstracts submitted will be acknowledged through email within 5 working days upon receipt. Please contact the Secretariat if you do not receive the acknowledgement email.
- 2. The Scientific Committee decisions are final.
- **3.** The Organising Committee reserves the right to make changes to all oral and poster presentation schedules.
- 4. Presenting authors will receive an email notification on abstract acceptance or rejection by 15 June 2023.
