The 2023-2026 ICATCH Grant Cycle is now open!

International Community Access to Child Health, a program of American Academy of Pediatrics Section on Global Health, invites you to apply for a **3-year grant of \$2000/year** for a community health project in a low-income or low-middle-income country.

Eligible projects: Any project providing clinical care to children; health education for children, adolescents, or parents; or training for health care providers treating infants, children, and/or adolescents, in the categories of physical or developmental disabilities, childhood or adolescent mental health, newborn health, nutrition/malnutrition, and care of hospitalized children.

Eligible people: All healthcare professionals (including doctors, nurses, social workers, psychologists, midwives, dentists, physical therapists, health educators, public health professionals, and others working with pediatric patients and caregivers), whether associated with institutions or applying individually.

Eligible places: Projects may occur in any World Bank-designated low-income or low-middle-income nation.

Application deadline: December 9, 11:59 PM Central (US; December 10, 5:59 AM UTC).
