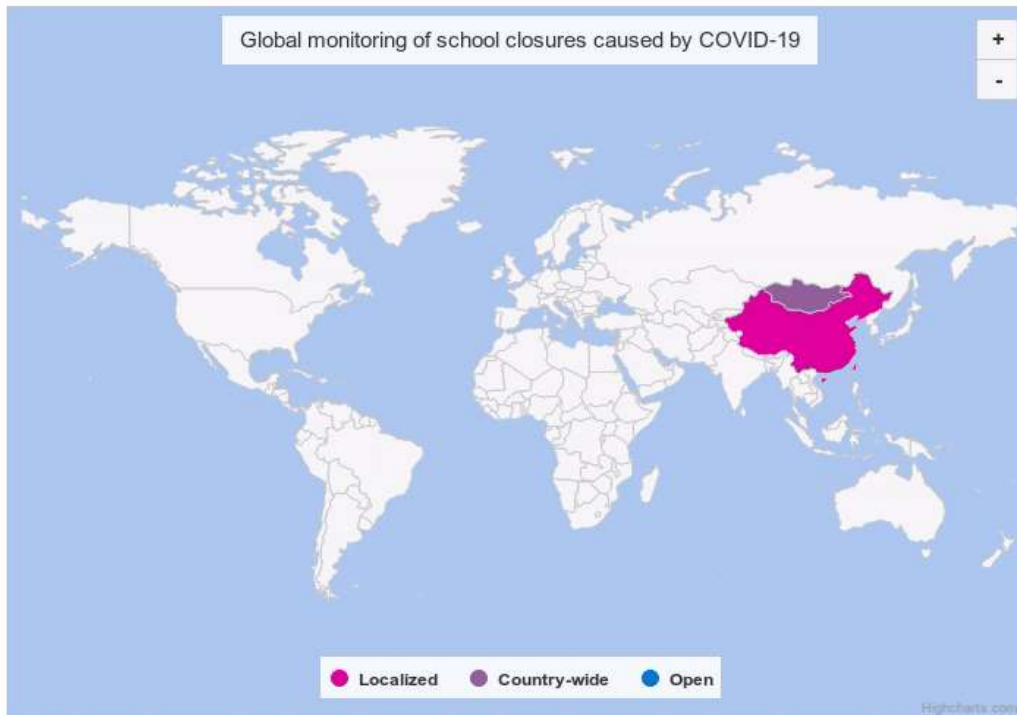


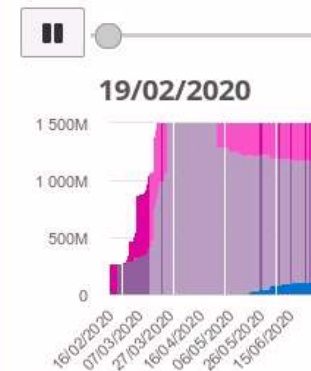

Visualize evolution over time.

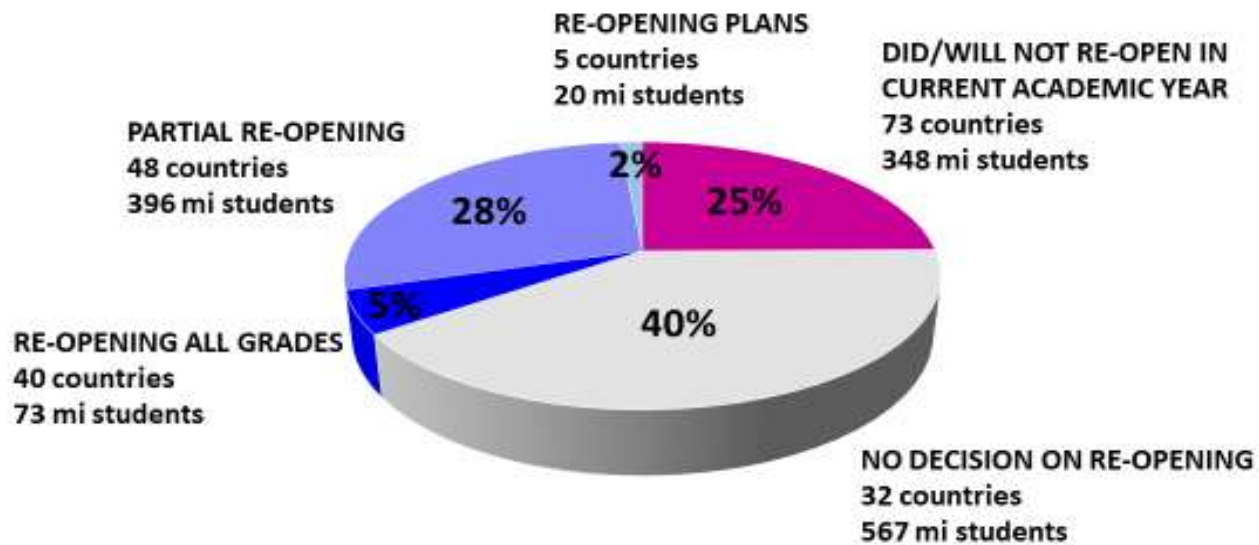


999,014 affected learners

New guidance

Build on lessons learned from initial COVID-19 response:

- **Identify risks:** equity, learning discontinuity, protection, teacher well-being
- **Conditions:** accessibility, curricula, teacher support
- **Processes:** coordination, consultation, communication, financing
